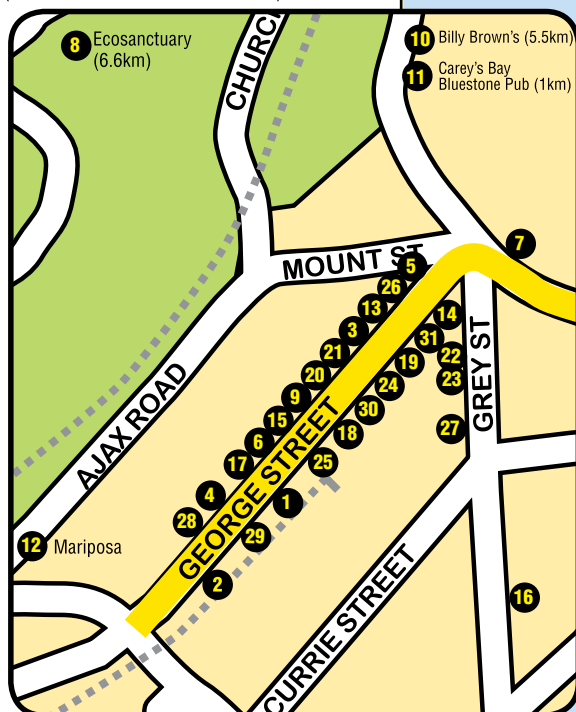

PORT WALKS

1 & 1a Carey's Bay & Boiler Point Walk:

Flat and easy walk. From the Port Otago building follow the path of Macandrew Road. At the carpark beside the Port Chalmers Rowing Club, follow the track to Boiler Point. At the end are sheltered circular seats, picnic tables and good fishing. Lovely views of fisherman's wharf and slightly further round views of the harbour. (15min) Continue on Past the Rowing Club to scenic Carey's Bay and the Historic Carey's Bay hotel for wonderful food and Coffee. (20min)

2 To Careys Bay via Lady Thorn Dell and Cemetery:

Follow Mount Street past Iona Church and turn right up Church Street. Over the railway crossing (old cemetery to the left at the electricity substation). For Lady Thorn Dell continue up church street, climb the viewing platform for lovely photos over the Wharf area and the town (15 mins). Continue up Church Street to the cemetery and picturesque Carey's Bay (20 mins). For fitter walkers there is a marked track on left past the Lady Thorn Dell called Brailey's Track, this goes further up the hill to the Scott Memorial (30 mins).

3 To Flagstaff & Sculpture Garden:

Walk up Grey Street behind Town Hall to Anglican Church, turn into Scotia Street, then uphill beside handrail to Aurora Terrace. A short steep walk, but well worth the views (10 minutes).

4 Flagstaff/Sculpture Garden down to Back Beach:

First goes steeply down from the top beside handrail, then a gentler zigzag slope to Peninsula Beach Road to come out beside Boat Ramp and Port Chalmers Yacht Club (10 mins).

5 Back Beach Walking Track:

Start beside Port Chalmers Yacht club, follow the easy gravelled track on reclamation edge. Picnic table and chairs in circular mounded and shrubbed area at the end. Good fishing along harbour edge (5 mins).

6 Full Coastal/Back Beach Walk:

Start at Port Otago Building, walk through shopping area, left into Wickliffe Terrace at the railway Crossing. Follow Wickliffe Terrace around to the right. It then becomes Victory Place which follows the headland, with lovely views south to the city. Carry on down the hill past Quarantine and Goat Islands to Back Beach Reserve. You will see resident geese and some lovely old classic boats moored in the Bay by the boat ramp. Sealed road then takes you back to Port Otago and main shopping area. This map shows (in red) several shorter tracks off the main walk, some have handrails but all are quite steep as they rise to link with the upper levels of town (45 mins).

7 The Skyline Walk:

From the Scott Memorial (Rangi Park car park) a track winds through native bush to a seat on the skyline for wonderful views. Return as you came or take the other marked track descending to Blueskin Road. Cross the road to descend to the Old Cemetery and Church Street again. Good walking shoes are advisable as this track is difficult and can be muddy and slippery (30 mins).
